

Account Code System

The account codes for the Budget are governed by Handbook II of the Federal Dept of Education and as amended by the State of Vermont.

The five sections are broken down as follows

AA-BB-CCCC-DDDDD-EEE

AA Fund codes

- 00 is General Fund
- 50 is National School Lunch Program
- 51 is Stafford Tech Center
- 99 is the sum of all grants. See the grant detail separately for that detail.

BB Location or School Codes

- 10 is General Elementary for shared expenses
- 11 is Rutland Intermediate School
- 12 is Pierpoint Learning Center
- 14 is Northeast
- 15 is Northwest
- 17 is Success Program
- 30 is Co-Curricular activities at RHS
- 31 is Rutland High School
- 32 is Rutland Middle School
- 99 is a summary of all grants combined.

CCCC Function Codes

- These are functional/organizational descriptions for the expense and are printed throughout the list above.
- For example, 2400 is school administration

DDDDD Object Codes

- These are called object codes and describe the nature of an expense and are printed above.
- For example, 52100 is health insurance

EEE Program Codes

- These codes help to define an account in an extra way when needed.
- For example, for every special education expense that we can seek reimbursement, we use 211 here.
