The Rutland City voters are hereby warned to meet on Monday, March 5, 2018 at 6:30 PM at the Longfellow Administration Building, 6 Church Street to transact the following business:

- Article 1 To hear the report of the Rutland City Board of School Commissioners
- Article 2 To transact any other business proper to come before said meeting

The meeting shall be recessed to reconvene on Tuesday, March 6, 2018 for the purpose of voting by Australian Ballot at the usual polling places between the hours of 7:00 AM and 7:00 PM on the following:

To elect the following School Board Commissioners:

- a. A City School Board Commissioner for a term of three (3) years
- b. A City School Board Commissioner for a term of three (3) years
- c. A City School Board Commissioner for a term of three (3) years

- Article 1 Shall the voters of Rutland City School District approve the school board to expend \$52,635,059 which is the amount the school board determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? It is estimated that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in education spending of \$14,725 per equalized pupil. This projected spending per equalized pupil is 0.6 % (six tenths of one percent) lower than spending for the current year.
