

**Rutland City Public Schools**  
**Opening of School Information 2021-2022**

**ALL SCHOOLS WILL OPEN WEDNESDAY, September 1, 2021.** See below for starting dates for Kindergarten.

**NORTHEAST:** 1st and 2nd grade morning car drop off is 8:45- 9:00 beginning September 1st. Bus pick up and drop off times are according to busing letters sent late August. Kindergarteners follow Kindergarten orientation schedule outlined in their letters sent mid-August.

Kindergarten Orientation days: Northeast kindergarten students will report for orientation on September 1 from 9:30-11:30 or 12:30-2:30 as assigned in their letter. Orientation times for September 2, 3, and 7 are 9:30-11:30 or 12:30-3:00 as assigned. All kindergarten students will attend 9:00 to 1:00 on September 9, and 10. Kindergarteners begin full days on September 13.

First Day Celebration - In-person, first day celebrations will be only for students and teachers.

Open House - "Meet the Teachers' Night" (aka "Open House") takes place 6:00 September 29th. More information to follow.

**NORTHWEST:** 1st and 2nd graders' morning car drop off time ranges from 8:30 - 8:55 am beginning on September 1st in the car riders' circle on the south side of the building. Bus pick up and drop off times are according to busing letters sent late August.

Kindergarten Orientation - Northwest kindergarten students will receive letters in the mail in mid-August telling them if they will attend the morning or afternoon orientation days: 9:15 - 11:15 am OR 12:00 - 2:00 pm on September 1, 2, 3, and 7. Kindergarteners do not attend school on September 8th, and they attend half days, 8:50 - 12:00 on September 9th and 10th, as indicated in their letters. Again, kindergartners begin full days on September 13th.

First Day Celebration - At this point in time, in-person first day celebrations will be only for students and teachers.

Open House - "Meet the Teachers' Night" (aka "Open House") takes place on September 22nd.

**RUTLAND INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL**

ALL students begin school on Wednesday, September 1, 2021

Student arrival:

- School begins at 8:00am. Students may be on site starting at 7:45am. Students arriving after 8:10am will be marked tardy. Students are expected to go directly to their classroom upon arrival with the exception of those wanting breakfast at school. Those wishing to have breakfast at school will pick up breakfast in the cafeteria and then go directly to their classroom to eat.
- **Bus riders** will enter the building using our main entrance on Library Avenue.
- **Car riders and walkers in 3rd and 5th grades** will enter the building using the semi-circle staircase entrance on Church Street.
- **Car riders and walkers in 4th and 6th grades** will enter the building using the side door to the right of the semi-circle on Church Street.

School Dismissal:

- Students will begin dismissal starting at 2:42 pm. Students will exit the building through the same door that they entered.

## RUTLAND MIDDLE SCHOOL

- **First 7th Grade Day:** Wednesday, September 1, 2021
- **First 8th Grade Day:** Thursday, September 2, 2021
- **All students:** Friday, September 3, 2021

### Student Arrival:

- All students who take buses or who are car riders will be dropped off on Library Avenue between 7:30 and 7:45 AM.
- No students will be allowed in the building before 7:30 AM.
- All students are members of one cohort, called a “house”. Each house has a separate entrance. Faculty and Staff will be outside helping students enter appropriately.

*Birch: Front Entrance*

*Maple & BRIDGES: Enter under back catwalk between RIS/RMS*

*Hickory: Enter through Grove Street*

- Breakfast can be picked up at all three entrances and taken with students to eat in their classrooms.

### Student Dismissal:

- Students will exit the building from the same entrance they entered.
  - RMS dismissal will begin at 2:26 PM
- \*Tuesday is RMS's Early Release day.* Dismissal will begin at 1:31 PM on Tuesdays.

RMS Open House (in person at RMS) will take place August 24, 2021 at 5:30.

## RUTLAND HIGH SCHOOL

The school year will start with an orientation day which will include an opportunity for students to meet their teachers, participate in a class assembly, and follow an abbreviated class schedule.

### On Wednesday, September 1:

- **Freshmen** only report to school at 7:50 am and you will be done at 12:00 noon;
- **Juniors** only report to school at 11:15 am and you will be done at 3:00 pm.

### On Thursday, September 2:

- **Sophomores** only report to school at 7:50 am and you will be done at 12:00 noon;
- **Seniors** only report to school at 11:15 am and you will be done at 3:00 pm.

On Friday, September 3: all students report to school by 7:50 for a full day of classes.

Breakfast and lunch will be available beginning on September 1.

Bus schedules for Grades 9-12 are advertised separately.

## GROVE STREET CAMPUS

- Students who have been accepted into the Alternative Education Program at the 77 Grove Street will report for orientation as indicated in their letter.
- Class schedules will be determined at orientation.

**STAFFORD TECHNICAL CENTER** - The first day of classes for area students is Wednesday, September 1, 2020. Students are asked to report to their scheduled class/program area upon arrival. Breakfast and lunch are available. Students should contact their home school for busing schedules.

**RUTLAND MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOL ALLEN STREET CAMPUS** - All students scheduled to attend ASC are to report at 8:30 a.m. on Wednesday, September 1, 2021. Staff will be calling families with specific busing information and schedules. Families are invited to our Open House Barbeque on Thursday, September 30, 2021, from 4–6:00 p.m.
