



Rutland City Public Schools Announces Contract Agreements through June 30, 2024

The Rutland City Board of School Commissioners and Administration are pleased to announce the ratification of three labor agreements with collective bargaining units for more than 400 educational professionals and administrators employed by District. Last year, the Board and Administration were also pleased to reach agreement with the bargaining unit for employees who provide facilities-related and transportation services for the District. All four of these agreements extend through June 30, 2024.

The School Board's objectives have always included offering competitive compensation to District employees, including both salaries and employee benefit programs, that will retain, motivate, and attract the excellent and dedicated teams who provide and support a superior education for our students year after year.

School Commissioners, the Staff Relations and Finance Committees, District administration, and the collective bargaining units all invested significant effort to address complex educational, financial, and COVID-related issues that challenge our schools. Everyone did so within a fiscally responsible framework, one that considers city tax payers and the School District's long-term financial soundness.

We are also encouraged that further progress has been made in improving mutual understanding and appreciation of the important contributions made every day by all RCPS employees on behalf of our students and community. The Board thanks all employees for their ongoing commitment to RCPS, and for all that is accomplished together to make Rutland a great place to live and to educate our children.
